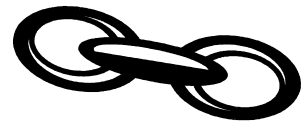

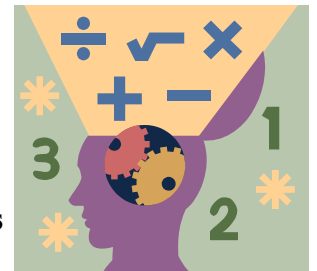

Our fourth Continental Math meet was held on January 7, 2010. Listed below are the winners (with 4 or more correct) by grade.

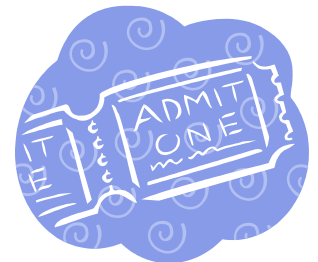

There is no fee for Butler County residents, however parents are required to register by calling 863-6129 ext. 27.

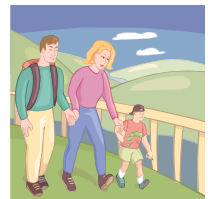
CURRICULUM FOCUS:
