Fundraising Made Easy With The
Kroger Neighborhood Reward Program

Dear Parents,

September, 2011

As we have in the past, our school is still participating in the Kroger Neighborhood Reward Program. This is an easy fundraiser for St. Peter's PTO and it uses money that we would spend anyways at the grocery.

Here is a REMINDER on how the program works:

- Make sure you have a Neighborhood Reward Gift Card (they cannot be purchased in the stores).
- Shop for your groceries at Kroger.
- BEFORE the cashier begins to ring your purchases, and in a separate transaction, you simply "load" money on to your Reward card (cash, check, debit, credit). You can load your card with any amount up to \$500 in the store. You are able to do this at the register or at the Customer Service Desk when you enter the store.
- After you load your card and pay for it, the cashier can then ring your purchases. You are then able to pay with your Reward Gift card. You can purchase any merchandise in a Kroger store with the **exception of these services**. Services include: *Money Orders, Western Union, Lottery Tickets, Stamps, Ticket Master, Kroger Gift Cards, Green Dot cards and reloadable Visa and MasterCard*. Gift cards are now accepted at local Kroger Fuel Centers and Shell Fuel Centers.
- The balance on your card will then show on the bottom of your receipt.

Every time we reach \$5000 or more in reloads within Kroger's 4 week cycle, St. Pete's will earn 4% of the total amount. So for every \$5000 in reloads, our school will receive \$200.

Also, Kroger has a wide variety of gift cards available for purchase in their stores. Please think about purchasing your gift cards at Kroger with your Reward card so the 4% can be given to our school. Birthdays, Christmas presents, etc....it's just so easy!!

Please remember to use your card EVERY time you shop at Krogers! If you have misplaced your card or need one for you and/or family or friends please let me know.
